

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 18-10950**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SALINA CODE SECTION 42-268 PERTAINING TO  
CONDITIONAL USES IN THE C-2 DISTRICT AND REPEALING THE EXISTING SECTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of Salina, Kansas:

**Section 1. Amendment.** Section 42-268 of the Salina Code is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 42-268. Conditional uses.**

Conditional uses in the C-2 district are as follows:

- (1) Drinking establishment;
- (2) Electronic Cigarette establishments;
- (3) Hardware stores;
- (4) Package liquor stores;
- (5) Research laboratories (limited to medical records, statistical research, etc.);
- (6) Restaurants, excluding drive-up window service and drive-in establishments;
- (7) Small animal hospitals, providing that such facility is completely enclosed and that no odor or noise is discernible outside the structure;
- (8) Tattoo parlors and body piercing studios;
- (9) Telephone exchanges and telephone transmission equipment structures;
- (10) Tobacco shops;
- (11) All permitted and conditional uses in the R-3 district, provided that they shall be governed by the requirements of the R-3 district.

**Section 2. Repealer.** Existing Salina Code Section 42-268 is repealed.

**Section 3. Effective.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:

On August 6, 2018, the City Commission passed Ordinance No. 18-10950. This ordinance amends the list of conditional uses in the C-2 (Neighborhood Shopping) district by deleting taverns from the list of conditional uses in the C-2 (Neighborhood Shopping) district and by adding drinking establishments to the list of conditional uses.
