

Do's and Don'ts of the Landfill

DO:

Follow all directions:

- Stay on approved landfill roadways
- Watch out for heavy equipment and trucks
- Read and pay close attention to all posted signs
- Take all materials to the appropriate locations as directed by the scale-house attendant

DON'T:

Throw away the following:

- Hazardous Wastes
- Flammable Liquids or Solids
- Corrosive Wastes
- Toxic Wastes
- Reactive Wastes
- Explosives
- Items containing Freon
(Unless accompanied by Freon removal certificate)

Landfill Fees

Tipping Fee \$32.34/ton
(\$10.00 minimum)

Loads with 25%
or more of concrete,
rock, or brick

Tires:
Car/Light truck:
(up to 16") \$2.00/tire

Truck:
(up to 11/24.5") \$5.20/tire

Truck/Equipment:
(up to 18.4") \$19.30/tire

Heavy Equipment:
(18.4" to 23.5") \$25.80/tire

Heavy Equipment:
(23.5" to 30.5") \$61.20/tire

Extra charge for tires mounted on wheels

Limbs FREE to Saline County residents
Commercial Haulers-1/2 tipping fee


