General Conditions for Pool Approval would include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. All electrical work associated with the pool is to be GFCI protected. The pool shall not be located within 22' vertically or 10' horizontally from overhead electrical conductors.
2. Enclosure of pools: Every pool with a depth of more than 24 inches (2 ft.) at any point shall be enclosed by a fence or wall (Salina Municipal Code Sec 8-468).
3. The door of a dwelling which opens onto a pool enclosure will need to be equipped with an alarm.
4. Do not attach extension cords to pool equipment.
5. A copy of the "Above Ground Permanent Swimming Pool" brochure has been attached to this permit. Please read it and let us know if you have any further questions.
