One source of elevated blood lead levels in Saline County children may be exposure to lead dust from remodeling projects. As a result inspections have increased and contractors are receiving fines for failing to follow the Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) rule. Contractors, painters, property managers and landlords working on homes, apartments and child-occupied facilities built before 1978 must be LSWP Certified. Attend this 8-hour class to learn important practices and protocols to meet the RRP rule and minimize exposure to lead contamination from construction projects.
