



Frequently Asked Questions

-Can we bring food or drinks into the park?

No, we do not allow outside food or drinks. We do allow one water bottle per person. We also ask that you leave the coolers in your vehicle.

-Can we bring life jackets or other floatation devices for the kids?

If the floatation device is Coast Guard Approved, we will allow you to bring it in. This will not include the following: blow up tubes, water wings or any other floatation device with an air chamber.

-How can I get a locker?

Our lockers do not have locks on them; you can bring your own combination lock or purchase one from us for \$5.00. If you use the lockers, please use a lock. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

-Do we pay to use a tube?

No, the tubes are free of charge and are available on a first come, first serve basis.

-What is your weather policy?

Kenwood Cove will open if the air temperature is 72 degrees or warmer and the sky is clear. On cloudy days, the air temperature must be at least 75 degrees in order to open. Additional factors such as water temperature and the forecast for the day will also be taken into consideration. Aquatic staff suggests patrons sign up for RecZone or check the website to ensure that the facility will be open. Weather conditions will be checked at 8:30am (on Swim Lesson days), at 12:00pm and again at 3:00pm. Please remember that we do not offer refunds due to weather conditions.
