## **INTERPRETATION SUMMARY**

It is the interpretation of the Building Services division that when foundation designs and soils analysis results are not submitted for structures regulated by the IRC that are over 400 square feet, a minimum of two #4 minimum grade 40 continuous reinforcement bars shall be added to all footings. Although previously undocumented, this policy has been a long standing and widely accepted requirement for decades according to most accounts by staff and contractors.
